FIRST, THE NAVY

Admiral Fletcher

says our Navy could successfully defend us against any navy in the world except England.* * A handwritten note against this quotation reads, "Use J.P.M.'s instead."

Admiral Badger

says that the German navy is not superior to ours.

SO

After annihilating our Navy, the enemy (only slightly bruised) faces our coast defenses.

SECOND, THE COAST DEFENSE

"Our coast defenses are all right" says General Goethals "Our coast defenses are almost impregnable" says General Crosier "Our coast fortifications are impregnable" says General Weaver

SO

When he has blown up our coast defenses, the enemy (a "little" damaged) is met by yet another line of defense:

THIRD, THE ARMY

GENERAL NELSON A. MILES reminds us that to meet an invading force, we have 100,000 men in the Regular Army 300,000 men of military age who have passed through the Army 400,000 men of military age who have served in the National Guard 135,000 men who have received military training in the Colleges Total 935,000 trained men

THE HOUR OF DECISION depicts Uncle Sam in centre facing two paths,

From 1896 to 1915 we spent more for military purposes than Germany spent and yet we complain bitterly of Germany's "militarism". Militarists say that there always has been and always will be war. The same was said of slavery and the duel. War must pass with the other relics of barbarism.

If the United States increases its Army and Navy, other countries will be forced to do the same in order to keep up with us. Is it not better for America to be the Peace-maker rather than the Pace-maker?

Militarists say, "In time of peace prepare for war."

Europe prepared for war and it got what it prepared for. Shall we prepare for war?

WE PROTEST

against the effort to divert public funds, needed in constructive programs for national health and well being, into the manufacture of engines of death.

The expenditures of the United States for the Army and the Navy are greater than those of any other nation in time of peace. Do we need more money for "preparedness"?

Large armies and navies do not prevent war. On the contrary they make it more possible. They are the powder magazines which any spark will set off. Witness Europe. WE URGE IMMEDIATE SUPPORT OF THE FOLLOWING PROGRAM

A congressional investigation as to the sources of the insistent demands for a large increase in army and navy appropriations.

WE URGE IMMEDIATE SUPPORT OF THE FOLLOWING PROGRAM

A public investigation of our present huge war budget so that every dollar now spent may bring 100% of efficiency.

WE URGE IMMEDIATE SUPPORT OF THE FOLLOWING PROGRAM

The calling of a Pan-American Congress for the purpose of developing the Monroe Doctrine into a democratic federation of the twentyone American Republics.

Our huge military appropriations will make similiar appropriations in Japan almost inevitable. Then the Jingoes will say it is to attack us.
