## Are we afraid of a Naval Engagement?

In 1914 Germany had 39 battleships built, building or authorized.

In 1914 the United States had 40 battleships, built, building or authorized.

In 1914 japan had 19 battleships built, building or authorized.

In 1914 Admiral Fletcher, commander of the Atlantic Fleet, stated that no navy in the world could hope to encounter our navy successfully, except that of England. We do not know what additions Germany has made in the meantime, but we do know that since then she has lost 69 ships, having a total tonnage of 238,904.

The United States additions authorized during the same period comprise three dreadnaughts, the largest in the world, and eighteen submarines.

## Do we fear an Invasion?

With 31 transport ships and 62 ships of war it took "the Mistress of the Seas" 33 days to move 33,000 unequipped troops from Canada to England.

With the biggest battle fleet in the world and absolute control of the Mediterranean, England has failed to make a successful landing at the Dardanelles.

Good coast defenses are stronger than the strongest attacking navy. Admiral Fletcher says modern coast defenses can repel any naval attack without the aid of a single battleship. Gen. Crozier, chief of Ordnance, says our coast defenses are the strongest in the world.
